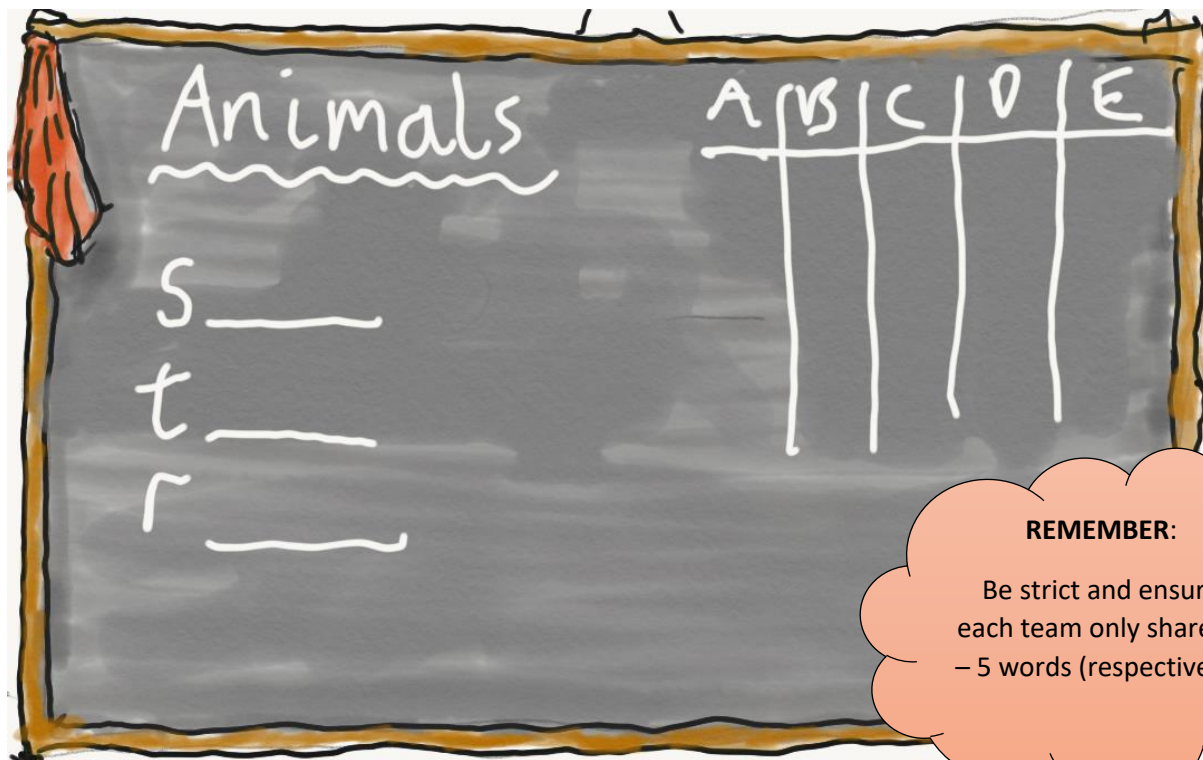




## What Am I Thinking?



**REMEMBER:**

Be strict and ensure each team only shares 3 – 5 words (respectively).

**Game Objective:** Pupils practice connecting words to categories and its first letter.

**Game Type:** Guessing Game

**Classroom Organisation:** Teams

**Language Area:** Vocabulary

**Useful for:** Revision, review, testing, building vocabulary

1. Choose at least 5 words you would like to revise with your pupils (these can be from any unit they have done).
2. Divide your class into roughly 5 teams (depending on your class size this may vary) and indicate this on the board (see picture above).
3. Write a category as a title (animals, fruit, vegetables, classroom objects etc.).
4. Write 3 to 5 words underneath showing only the first letter (you can start with only 3 words first to ease pupils into the game!).
5. Say 'I am thinking of three animals. Can you guess?' (or similar).
6. Pupils in each team write down or think of the words.
7. Ask a pupil from each team to share their words. Make sure you ask a different pupil from each team everytime so different pupils can participate!
8. The team with the most words that matches yours WINS 10 POINTS (second most 5 points, third most 2 points, one matches 1 point).
9. You can get a pupil from each team to ask the class once they get used to the game.
10. Pupils can play individually and keep record of their own scores!
